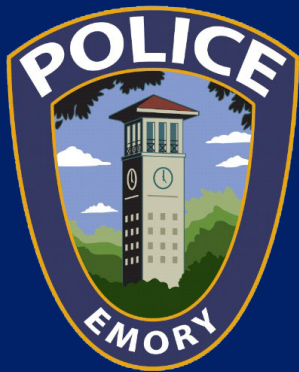


# STAY SAFE



## EMORY STANDS AGAINST VIOLENCE

All of Emory stands united against violence targeting our Asian and Asian American communities. The Emory Police Department (EPD) is here to serve and protect you - 24 hours a day.

## TIPS TO STAY SAFE

### Use the LiveSafe app

- **Report an issue:** If you feel threatened, you are being followed, or you have been the victim of a crime, report it to EPD immediately. Use LiveSafe to send text, picture, video, and audio messages directly to EPD. You can also chat with the department or share updates anonymously.
- **Get immediate assistance:** Connect with EPD any time via 'Emergency Options.' When you call or text from LiveSafe, we can track your location, which helps us respond quickly. (You can stop location tracking at any time after the call is placed.)
- **Request a virtual SafeWalk:** Ask a friend to be your "virtual escort." They can track your location and chat with you along the way. SafeWalk also allows you to virtually escort others.
- **Request an EPD Escort:** Call EPD and we'll escort you in person to your destination.

### Don't have LifeSafe? Download it today.

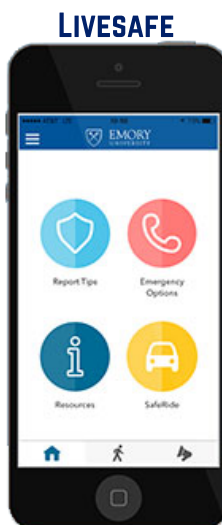
- Download "LiveSafe" from the App Store or Google Play (Enable location services and push notifications when prompted).
- Sign up using your Emory email address.
- Create a password and fill in your name.
- Search for "Emory University" to connect with the organization.

### Get a SafeRide

Request a ride anywhere on Emory's Clifton campuses from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. every day. To make a request: use the Transloc Rider app, visit [ondemand.transloc.com](http://ondemand.transloc.com) or call 404-727-7555.
